**NEW PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT: ENHANCED CARE MANAGEMENT**

In 2025, Interface launched a new Enhanced Care Management program. Enhanced Care Management (ECM) provides intensive, personalized support for high-needs individuals. ECM connects Medi-Cal members with a Lead Care Manager who coordinates complex medical, behavioral, and social needs such as housing, food, and transportation, aiming to improve health outcomes and reduce hospital visits by addressing the social determinants of health and providing in-home, community-based care. We have already provided this incredible service to over 120 clients, and expect to serve hundreds this year, ensuring that our most vulnerable community members receive the loving care and support they deserve.
