*Therapeutic groups offered to children who have been sexually abused and their non-offending parent/caregiver.

*Psycho-education and therapeutic process offered as soon as possible following disclosure so parents and children can lessen the early effects of sexual abuse: shame, self-blame, low self-esteem, poor social functioning, fear and isolation.

*By reducing the destructive feelings and processing through the abuse, children regain a sense of safety and trust, and learn to relate genuinely and spontaneously again.
